

Boeing AH-64 Apache Helicopter

The Boeing *AH-64 Apache* is an American four-blade, twin-turboshaft attack helicopter equipped with four hardpoints mounted on stub-*wing* pylons, typically carrying a mixture of AGM-114 Hellfire missiles and two rocket launchers. It is armed with a 30mm (M230 chain-gun). Apaches have served in combat during conflicts in Iraq, Afghanistan wars and other areas in the Middle East.
