

## Boeing C-17A Globemaster III Cockpit

The Boeing C-17 is a large military transport aircraft. It was developed for the United States Air Force from the 1980s to the early 1990s. The C-17 commonly performs tactical and strategic airlift missions, transporting troops and cargo throughout the world; additional roles include medical evacuation and airdrop duties.

**Seating:** 4 people: 2 pilots, two rear seat “observers”

**Paint Scheme:**

**Ext:** Air Force Gray

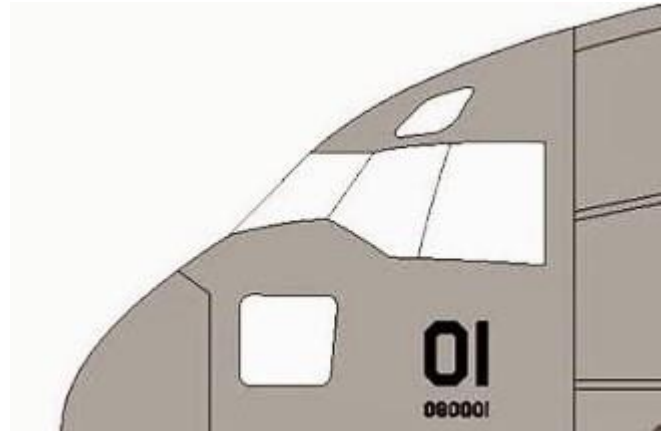
**Int:** Air Force Gray, multiple shades

**Instrument Panel:** There are five video display screens (color) with DVI and HDMI inputs, video playback required. This cockpit is equipped with HUDs

**Note:** Rear wall left side wild - Base of cockpit is equipped to be mounted on a gimbal.



**Dimensions:** L: 11 feet (nose to rear wall)  
W: 14 feet, 4 inches  
H: 10 feet, 3 inches  
Weight: Approx. 5,000 lbs.
