

Sikorsky UH-60 Black Hawk Helicopter

The UH-60, Black Hawk, helicopter is frequently used for military purposes. Black Hawks have served in combat during conflicts in Grenada, Panama, Iraq, Somalia, the Balkans, Afghanistan, and other areas in the Middle East. The Blackhawk has an evolutionary airframe, a large cabin which is capable of carrying 11 fully armed troopers. The US Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard use variants of the UH-60 helicopter.
