

Boeing C-17A Globemaster III Cockpit

The Boeing C-17 is a large military transport aircraft. It was developed for the United States Air Force from the 1980s to the early 1990s. The C-17 commonly performs tactical and strategic airlift missions, transporting troops and cargo throughout the world; additional roles include medical evacuation and airdrop duties.

Seating: 4 people: 2 pilots, two rear seat “observers”

Paint Scheme:

Ext: Air Force Gray

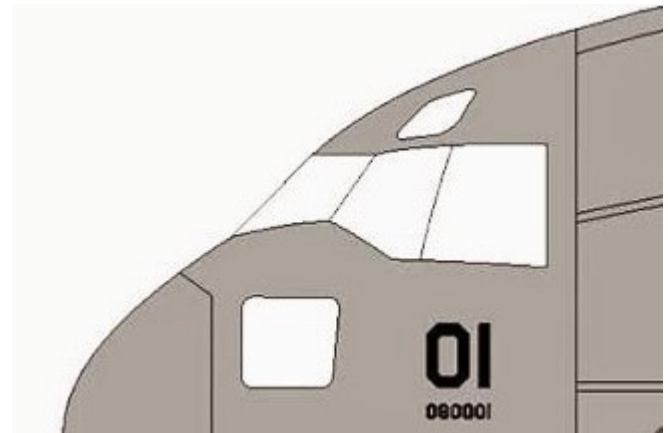
Int: Air Force Gray, multiple shades

Instrument Panel: There are five video display screens (color) with DVI and HDMI inputs, video playback required. This cockpit is equipped with HUDs

Note: Rear wall left side wild - Base of cockpit is equipped to be mounted on a gimbal.
