

## Mil Mi-8 / Mi-17 Helicopter

The Mil Mi-8 /Mi-17 helicopter is a medium twin-turbine helicopter, originally designed by the Soviet Union in the 1960s and introduced into the Soviet Air Force in 1968. It is now produced by Russia.
